Who is The Healed Project?

Founded in Philadelphia in 2014 by producer and songwriter **Tyrese S. Thomas**, **The Healed Project** is a billboard charting music platform built on a simple but powerful belief: music can help people heal, reconnect, and move forward.

What began as Thomas' personal response to his own life experiences has grown into a deeply expressive body of work centered on resilience, hope, joy, and the shared human experiences that connect people across cultures and communities. His songwriting is shaped not only by his own journey, but by the stories of people navigating change, loss, triumph, uncertainty, and the decision to begin again.

Musically, The Healed Project is rooted in the emotional depth of **gospel and soul**, while expanding far beyond any single tradition. Its sound moves fluidly through R&B, Afrobeats, house, dance, contemporary, and global influences, anchored by powerful ensemble vocals, intentional songwriting, and layered musical arrangements. Rather than being defined by genre, The Healed Project is defined by feeling—movement, connection, and emotional truth.

Over more than a decade, The Healed Project has built an independent catalog that includes **eight singles, one EP, and three full-length albums**, reflecting both the evolution of Thomas as a songwriter and the expanding musical language of the Project. That creative work has translated powerfully to the stage. The Healed Project has appeared twice on **FOX 29 Philadelphia's *The Q Show***, headlined **City Winery Philadelphia** on multiple occasions, and performed at festivals, concerts, and special events throughout the region. The Project has also shared stages with artists including **PJ Morton, Common, Anthony Hamilton & The Hamiltones, John P. Kee, Jason Nelson, Doobie Powell, Corey Henry & Friends**, and others.

Today, that evolution is fully realized in **The Feel Good Concert Experience**, The Healed Project's current live presentation. Built around joy, movement, healing, and community, the show blends the Project's wide-ranging musical influences into an immersive, audience-centered experience where participation and connection are central to the performance.

That same spirit carries into the Project's 2026 release, **"Just Dance Again,"** a rhythm-driven record that fuses Afrobeats, contemporary R&B, and soul with the signature ensemble vocal sound that defines The Healed Project. At its core is a simple invitation: after life has interrupted you, challenged you, or changed you, you still have permission to move again.

More than a decade into its journey, The Healed Project continues to evolve without losing sight of its foundation. The mission is not only to create music that sounds good, but music that **means something**—music that meets people where they are while creating space for joy, reflection, movement, and connection.

As The Healed Project enters its next chapter, including an expanded festival presence and new creative work planned for 2027, its mission remains clear: **to create impactful experiences, emotionally resonant music that celebrates resilience, brings people together, and leaves audiences feeling better than when they arrived.**
